Gathering Area Renovation

“Dust and clean out shelving in the gathering area” was the assignment I volunteered for about six months ago. I completed that task, but after considerable thought, followed by consultation with Pastor Molly, our Board chair, and the Property Committee Co-chairs, the job morphed into “Renovate the gathering area to create a more contemporary and useful space”. I enlisted a co-worker, Debbie Hockensmith, and with a go-ahead from the Executive Board we asked for and received funding (\$6800.) from the Memorial Fund.

It has taken some time, but the project is nearly complete. The furniture that had been in there has been either re-purposed in our building or donated to Habitat for Humanity Re-Store. A custom designed coffee and serving bar was built and installed by Kentucky Prison Industries and a new TV was donated by Lee and Diana Thomas. We have purchased a new coffee maker, cafe style tables and chairs, and two upholstered side chairs. A small beverage refrigerator has been ordered to install in the coffee bar. With the addition of a few decorative items, the transformation will be complete!

I hope we will think of this area now as our church’s family room. We will try to always have cold drinks in the fridge and snacks in the cabinet. The coffee maker has a carafe but also can brew a single cup of tea, hot chocolate or coffee. There are games, puzzles and books in the bookcases and the TV can tune to local channels and U-Tube or play DVD’s. Closed circuit TV is in the future. If you have any ideas or suggestions for further enhancements please let me, Debbie Hockensmith, or a Property Committee member know.

This new look creates an area for all kinds of hospitality from meetings and social events to quiet one on one conversation. If you haven’t seen it, please stop by, check it out, and make yourself at home!
